Reported by a homeowner on 8/23/2026:

A resident who went to walk on our trails noticed that someone was sleeping on the bench nearest the playground, and homeless person sat up on the bench and looked over at our resident. The resident took a few pictures to send to the HOA Board for a crime awareness report and asked if the Sheriff Patrol could be contacted to remove the homeless person. Resident could not walk and enjoy our trails because of the risk of damage if approaching this person. Since the resident asked to remain anonymous, and by the time the pictures were sent, the homeless person was already gone so the non-emergency number was not called this time.

Below is the picture taken from the resident reporting this.



The MUD#248 security committee was contacted regarding this as an “area of concern” for the Sheriff Patrols in the MUD district. Because our assigned Deputy only starts his shift in the MUD district at 10am, the Sargeant in charged will take on this effort to continue watching the trails and bench early morning until the homeless is seen by the Sargeant who will approach the homeless person and warn them to leave the area permanently, and if they are still seen afterwards, they will be arrested.
