After reading the White Oak Springs July 2026 newsletter and our article regarding a “check-washing incident” with a check paid to Best Trash that was intercepted in the mail and illegally cashed, a homeowner also reported something similar happen to them.

For awareness, this report is submitted by the homeowner. The homeowner had two (2) checks go missing sent by mail in the last month. USPS (United States Postal Service) has not accounted for this, nor done anything.

Although the HOA has recently completed a project to renew the clustered mailboxes cement pads as well as refresh the paint on the back, sides, and top of the units, this project is not related to the missing checks reported. However, if you are missing important mail that is sent by USPS, please DO NOT HESITATE to report this to our Cypress Postal Office asap so they can do their own investigation into the matter.
